



8" Cake Decorating Contest

Do you have a great idea for a decorated cake? Here's an opportunity for amateur* cake decorators to put their creative talents to the test!!

Entry/Judging: Saturday, April 27. 8"cakes on a 10" board will be accepted from 10 a.m. till 12 noon. Judging will begin at 12 noon.

Location: Mushroom Market Tent on the corner of Broadway and Court St.

Display: Saturday, April 27 at the Mushroom Market (large tent) on the corner of Broadway & Court Street. Cakes will be displayed 10 a.m. until 7 p.m. on Saturday, and until 5 p.m. on Sunday. You may pick up your cake at 5 p.m. on Saturday. Cakes will be disposed if not picked up by 5 p.m. Sunday, April 28.

Announcement of Winners: Saturday, April 27 at 12:30 p.m. at Mushroom Market

Categories: Amateur (*One who pursues an activity for pleasure instead of money)

- Child (6 years to 12 years)
- Youth (13 to 17 years)
- Adult (18 years and over)

Theme: Cakes can be decorated in any theme.

Judging: Entries will be judged on a point system. Criteria are:

- Design/creativity
- Presentation/overall impact
- Use of mushrooms in the design.

Judging will be conducted by a panel of judges selected by the Mountain Mushroom Festival committee. Judges' decisions are final.

Rules:

- The cake must be made and decorated by the person entering the contest. Children (ages 6 – 8) may receive adult assistance with baking the cake, but cake MUST be decorated solely by the child entrant.
- All entries must 8" on a 10" board.
- Cake can be baked or a dummy cake, non-edible props may be used for decoration and structure.

Prizes for all age divisions: All winners in each category will receive a festival rosette, local artisan handcrafted item from an Estill Arts Council member, and bragging rights.
